

The Benefits of a Standardised Educational Resource

The stimulus for developing a PowerPoint teaching package was to produce a professional, standardised educational resource. Flexibility was key to its success; adaptable for the target audience and time available for sessions and easily transferable from trust to trust with an evidence-based content. To ensure that patients receive evidence based quality care, the role of the specialist stoma care nurse needs to be widely understood within the multidisciplinary team, thus ensuring a smooth journey through the patient pathway. Education is fundamental in ensuring a greater understanding for all involved in the delivery of stoma care. A project team worked to integrate these elements, unifying resources already in use and conveying the same standardised educational message.

From completed evaluation forms following each teaching session, the illustrated data shows the responses from a range of the questions.

Data has been collated and analysed from the teaching sessions, these results and verbal feedback from the nurses delivering the sessions have formed the basis of the updates to the package for a successful Royal College of Nursing reaccreditation in 2014.
